I am the Petitioner and I state the following information is true:

I hereby ask the court to issue an Order renewing the Restraining Order in this matter that was originally signed on March 7, 20 18 (date of *original* order) for a period of one year, and continuing the security amount set forth in the original restraining order or in such other amount as the court deems appropriate.

Also, I recently filed against him in small claims for OK of the money he stole from me and I have a concern about retaliation.

He has previously gotten violent with me including threats with guns and rushing at me with a large tire iron. I also know that he continues to have access to guns and has violated this part of the protective order. I'm also 99% certain that I saw him drive past my house several months ago. He is a serial predator with a ~20 year history in the U.S. of defrauding women he seduces. He has intimate knowledge of my home's security systems and has previously tampered with my security cameras to delete evidence of stealing from me. While I and about a dozen+ other victims know him to be dangerous, he appears highly motivated to avoid any criminal charges. He's generally able to dodge civil matters and therefore I ask the court to renew the Restraining Order for a period of 1 year, and continue this P.O. the security amount entered in the original order

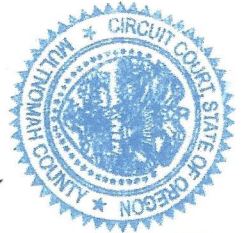
